

## Insurance Coverage – Is Your Foot Care Covered?

Some insurance companies in Ontario do provide reimbursements for foot care (percentage of coverage may vary among insurance providers or plans).

In all cases, <u>you will need to ask</u> your family doctor, or nurse practitioner for a prescription for **'medical foot care' by a foot care nurse**. Your insurance plan will advise you how and where to submit this.

As of May 2023 – this is what we know of some of the benefit plans in our area (though all information must be verified by you with your provider).
